Dear Prof. Berisha,

As chairman of the board of trustees of the Zietzschmann-Preuss award, it is my pleasant duty to inform you that after thorough evaluation, you and your co-authors have been selected as laureate of the 2017's Zietzschmann-Preuss award for your very nice publication on the "Angiogenesis in the Ovary - The Most Important Regulatory Event for Follicle and Corpus Luteum Development and Function in Cow - An Overview", published in Anatomia, Histologia, Embryologia in 2016.

Each year, in memory of the embryologist Otto Zietzschmann and of the donator of the prize, Fritz Preuss, the board of trustees of the ZP-award, which consists of the editorial board members of Anatomia Histologia Embryologia, elects a laureate amongst the authors who published a paper on an embryological or reproductive topic in the previous year's edition of Anatomia Histologia Embryologia.

The board was very pleased with your elaborate, up-to-date and well-structured overview you gave on the regulatory processes involved in angiogenesis in the ovary, supported by your own findings, and indicated you, by democratic vote, as clear winner of the 2017's ballot. My sincere congratulations with this achievement!

Along with this award, the prize money of \$ 500,- is provided for the laureate.

I have to formally ask you whether you are accepting this prize.

In case you do, we need to make some arrangements on how and when the prize will be handed over. For European laureates, this is typically done during a small ceremony at the closing dinner of the next congress of the European Association of Veterinary Anatomists, which is held in Hannover in 2018 (presumptive date = from the 18th till the 21st of July).

I do sincerely hope to meet you at the EAVA conference for the award ceremony. However, if neither you nor one of your co-authors is able to attend, it can be arranged that the award and prize money is handed over at a separate occasion, or even by simple bank transfer, so don't feel obliged.
