

## Vacancy Announcement

The Leibniz Institute of Agricultural Development in Transition Economies (**IAMO**) in Halle (Saale) offers a

### PhD position (f/m/x)

within the Leibniz Junior Research Group “Rural well-being in transition: multidimensional drivers and effects on (im)mobility ([RuWell](#))”. The post is a part-time position (**65 %**) starting on **October 10th, 2022** at the earliest and fixed-term for **three years** (extension is possible). The salary will be according to the German Public Service Salary Scale (**E13 TV-L**). The successful candidate will be part of the *Department of External Environment for Agriculture and Policy Analysis*.

#### About the project:

Europe’s rural areas are threatened by a vicious cycle: as populations decrease, the well-being of those who stay back also declines, which further fuels outmigration. This Leibniz Best Minds project aims at decoding the link between well-being and (im)mobility among rural populations in East Germany and Southeast Europe by adding a new lens: the concept of place attachment as a crucial but so far neglected dimension of well-being. A Multidimensional Well-being Index (MWI) will be developed to analyse the underlying factors of (im)mobility of the rural population.

#### What we expect:

The regional focus of this position will be Southeast Europe. The applicant is expected to provide survey-based empirical evidence of the factors that drive or impede rural depopulation by designing and conducting innovative, cross-sectional household surveys in selected rural regions in Albania, Kosovo, Moldova, and Romania. Statistical analysis combined with qualitative research methods is foreseen to gain a deeper understanding of interactions of different quality of life composites – in particular with place attachment – and their effect on overall well-being and staying intentions.

#### What you should bring:

- Very good university degree (Master or Diploma) in agricultural or applied economics, human geography, or other social sciences;
- Very good knowledge of planning, designing, and implementing field research;
- Interest in the analysis of multidimensional well-being;
- Interest in utilizing both qualitative and quantitative research methods;
- Experience in empirical economic research (e.g. in the context of a thesis) is an advantage;
- Fluency in English reading, writing, and presenting and knowledge of the official language in one of the study regions -- Albanian, and Romanian;
- Very good communication and teamwork skills.

- A unique research and qualification opportunity within a diverse and motivated team of scientists that value interdisciplinary research, while placing great value on diversity of age, gender identity, race, sexual orientation, physical ability, religious belief, and ethnicity;

- Support for data collection, organization, and analysis.
- Close guidance and supervision in the process of writing the PhD thesis.

- The successful candidates will become members of the IAMO Graduate School and apply for a doctoral degree from Martin-Luther-University Halle-Wittenberg.

If you are excited to engage in interdisciplinary research on the intersection between well-being and (im)mobility in the context of rural communities in Southeastern Europe and push the boundaries of the well-being analysis beyond its traditional economic domain, we look forward to hearing from you.
