

ERASMUS+STAFF' MOBILITY

Call for Applications (Teaching and Training)

Deadline: Monday, 1st April, 2019

University of Prishtina – the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary (UP) announces a call for applications for staff mobility for the second semester of the school year 2018-19 (20-24 May 2019). The call is open to 1 administrative staff members and 1 teaching staff.

The Mobility is under K2 Action current Erasmus + Project “Creating Theory to Practice Centers for Innovation and Employment”. This Mobility is under the project objectives, concentrated on the work of the University of Applied Science of Salzburg. According to the vision of the Center, the staff participating in the mobility will need to enhance their understanding of the work of the Innovation/Business Centres, which can be applied back in University of Prishtina – the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary T2P. This is as well an opportunity to have job shadowing within your respective departments.

The mobility will last 5 days and will include visits/meeting with Student Services, Careers Academy, Business Support Centre, Technology Enhanced Learning Services, Academy of Excellence (Teacher Training), Academic in their curriculum area and industry visits.

Successful applicants are eligible to receive funds to partially support their visit, which may not cover all the actual expenses incurred.

Funds eligible for Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility are made up of two components:

- Individual Support (Subsistence) and
- Travel Contribution.

Individual Support (subsistence)

Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Germany, Greece, France, Italy, Malta, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain	140 EUR/day
Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey, former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia	110 EUR/day

Travel contribution is calculated using a [Travel distance calculator](#) supported up by the European Commission. Distance is calculated between start and end location of the mobility in straight lines from one location to another.

Beneficiaries proceeding on Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility should retain boarding cards/train tickets/other travel tickets which need to be submitted along with the documentation of the mobility.

Application & selection process

Application deadline is **Monday, 1st April 2019 until 4pm the latest.** Applicants should send Letter of motivation (one A4 page max) to Hysen Bytyqi at: hysen.bytyqi@uni-pr.edu . Shortlisted candidates will be called for an interview. Priority is given to permanent members of Administrative and academic staff and those who participate in the Erasmus Teaching Mobility Program for the first time; Results should be expected within a week from the application deadline;
