**ERASMUS+ STAFF MOBILITY (KA2)  
Call for Applications (Teaching and Training Mobilities)**

Deadline: Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2020

University of Prishtina – Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary T2P project and International Relations Office announces a call for applications for staff mobility for the summer semester of the Academic Year 2019-2020 (May 2020). The call is opened for 1 administrative staff member and 5 teaching staff. The selected staff members will perform their mobilities at University of Prishtina – Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary partner institution: North West Regional College/ NWRC, Northern Ireland.

The Mobility is under K2 Action current IBC-M Erasmus + Project “Creating Theory to Practice Centers for Innovation and Employment” and it will fall under the project objectives, concentrated on the work of the **NWRC Innovation Center**. According to the vision of the Center, the staff participating in the mobility will need to enhance their understanding of the work of the Innovation/Business Centres, which can be applied back in University of Prishtina – Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary T2P Center. This is as well an opportunity to have job shadowing within your respective departments.

The mobility will last for 5 days and will include visits/meeting with Student Services, Careers Academy, Business Support Centre, Technology Enhanced Learning Services, Academy of Excellence (Teacher Training), Academic in their curriculum area and industry visits.

Successful applicants will receive funds to support their visit. Funds eligible for Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility are made up of two components:

- Individual Support (Subsistence) and
- Travel Contribution.

**Individual Support (subsistence)**

Receiving country	Amount (1-14 days)
United Kingdom	160 EUR/day

Travel contribution is calculated using a [Travel distance calculator](#) supported up by the European Commission. Distance is calculated between start and end location of the mobility in straight lines from one location to another.

Beneficiaries proceeding on Erasmus+ Teaching Mobility should retain boarding cards/train tickets/other travel tickets which need to be submitted along with the documentation of the mobility.

**Application & selection process**

Application deadline is **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2020 until 4pm the latest**. Evaluation panel will assess all requests and make final decision on selected candidates. Eligible applicants are the permanent members of administrative and academic staff who are fluent in English language and those who participate in the Erasmus Teaching Mobility Program for the first time. Results should be expected within a week from the application deadline.
